

No skill required. Just bring a paddle.




James River Country Club

Monday, October 6th, James River Country Club, 1500 Country Club Lane, Newport News, VA 23606. Shotgun start at 1:00 PM. Phone number is (757) 595-3357.

This is Bob Snyder's home course. The James River Country Club was voted the Best Golf Course in the 2021 and 2024 Coastal Virginia magazine's Best Reader's Choice Awards. Championship golf and recreational fun are punctuated by beautiful landscaping and picturesque views of the James River. Located behind the city of Newport News and tucked away from residential living with no houses on the golf course, James River Country Club provides a peaceful and enjoyable setting for a round of golf.

Immediately following golf, we will remain on premises to enjoy drinks and a gourmet meal (traditional Southern-style buffet of fried chicken and pulled pork with sides and 'fixins') served in the Oldest Golf Museum in the World.



Williamsburg Golf Club

Home course and country club of Jack Klevecz. Williamsburg Golf Club, formerly known as the Williamsburg Country Club, was established in 1958. The land, of great historical interest, was a site in the Civil War involving the capture of Fort Magruder, the center of the Williamsburg Line. During the Battle of Williamsburg, General Magruder's men were key in delaying Union troops on their way to Richmond. The fertile farmland, later served as a storage and shipping point for cattle in both World War I and II.

The course served as a host for the qualifying tournament of the 2004 USGA Women's Open along with several other premier Four Ball tournaments in Virginia. The entire course was rebuilt in 2009 with new tees, fairways, greens, bunkers, cart paths, a state-of-the art practice facility, and remodeled clubhouse. The club re-opened in June of 2010 as Williamsburg Golf Club, the leading private golf club on the peninsula.

Immediately following golf, we will remain on premises for a gourmet meal prepared by the award-winning culinary team.



Kiskiack Golf Club

Kiskiack Golf Club is home to one of the best 18-hole golf courses in the state of Virginia. Nestled along a ridge on a natural bluff in Williamsburg, Kiskiack features tree-lined fairways and gorgeous water features. While the course can be demanding for the experienced player, the course's open fairways and picturesque views allow beginners to enjoy a round of golf as well.

The Jamestown Course has served as proud host to the PGA Tour Michelob Open Qualifier on three occasions, bringing national attention to Williamsburg golf. It has received numerous awards including "One of the Ten Best Courses you can play in Virginia" by Golf Digest Magazine.
